He then completed his internal medicine internship at MUSC followed by his ophthalmology residency at the University of Texas Health Science Center in San Antonio, TX. Dr. Wannamaker went on to complete a 2-year vitreoretinal surgical fellowship at the renowned Cincinnati Eye Institute.
